Happy Anniversary, Our Lady of Victory Church!

On February 28, 1926, Bishop Christopher Byrne of the Diocese of Galveston dedicated our present church and gave it a new name, Our Lady of Victory. Our first church, dedicated to the leader of the twelve apostles, was affectionately called "Saint Peter's Motor Chapel," because the members welcomed the priest "motoring" over from Liberty. A trusting faith in God and devotion to Our Lady marked our church under the pastorate of Father Martin Collins in the difficult 1920s, a time during which some people did not want us to be here. The people of our church did not lose heart, did not give up. They prayed, they persevered, they were victorious. Our Lady would not allow her church to be destroyed.

LENTEN OBLIGATIONS

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence. Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

FASTING

Catholics from age 18 through 59 are permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

ABSTINENCE

Catholics age 14 and up abstain from meat (mammals & fowl) on Fridays in honor of the sacrifice of Christ.

As part of the processing of returning to "normal" Church life, we will resume (somewhat) the reception of Holy Communion in the pre-pandemic way at the beginning of March. Two lines will come up to the altar and receive Communion from me or the one Communion Minister. Those of you sitting in the side pews will also come up to receive. Two lines will also come up at daily Mass. If you're not comfortable with this pattern yet, please let me know and I or the Minister will bring Communion to you. There are no plans at this time to restore the People's drinking from the cup. – *Father Ross*
